

Using Summative Assessment for Progression – YR and Year 1

Outline

This is a programme of support to enable all teachers to make confident summative assessments, consider the information within a continuum of learning and development, and use the information to ensure a seamless transition to Year 1. The resources and online training will enable all teachers to:

- assess core aspects of learning and development;
- establish the information that this gives in relation to the continuum of learning and development;
- use the information above to report to parents and form the basis of discussions and/or key information packs used in transition, to enable each child to continue through their educational journey successfully.

The focus will be on assessment in the Reception year, with Year 1 teachers working in partnership to assess and support in applying understanding to enable effective transitions.

Description:

The training will consist of:

- Electronic documents A Padlet of resources to support teacher assessment, reporting and transition
- Online training 1.5 hours in length
- A 30-minute surgery slot to discuss individual issues and difficulties relating to assessment, will be available on 16th June 2021. Booking for these will be explained at the online training event.

Outcome:

Teachers will be enabled to:

- Make accurate assessments using core aspects of learning and development
- Use the continuum of learning and development to establish future actions for effective progression
- Understand how to assess attainment that may be less typical
- Use the information, in the most helpful format, for transition
- Use the information to report effectively to parents
