

# Preparing for the revised EYFS - Schools' Forum

**A revised EYFS framework will become statutory from September 2021.**

Alongside the statutory framework, there are other documents, such as the revised Development Matters and Birth to Three Matters which have been written to support effective pedagogy, a well sequenced curriculum and knowledge about child development.

This **forum** is an opportunity to discuss and debate the new expectations with advisers and teacher colleagues from across Norfolk, and to explore effective practice and implementation in readiness for September and beyond.

**It is intended that delegates attend forum meetings 1, 2 and 3. These will need to be booked separately so that you can choose the most convenient dates.**

**The training will consist of:**

- **Online meetings** to explore specific areas of learning and take part in discussion activities to enable improved confidence and give ideas for implementation. Each meeting will focus on:
  - progression through an effective curriculum
  - inclusive practice and improved outcomes
- A set of **online resources**
- **Gap tasks** – which will involve the practical application of key factors explored during the sessions. Feedback will be collated and fed into the content of the following forum event.

**Forum 1:**

- Overview of the key principles of the revised EYFS framework
- Focus on Communication and Language and Self-Regulation
- Information sharing from schools in Norfolk who have been using the revised framework as 'Early Adopters'

**Forum 2:**

- Focus on Literacy and Mathematics
- Discussion - supporting children's progress
- Successful strategies for implementation
- Effective assessment

**Forum 3:**

- Monitoring children's progress, making a difference for children who need it most
- Focus on Understanding the World and Expressive Arts and Design
- Reflect on your curriculum
- Statutory assessment requirements and how these link to readiness for Y1
