Preparing for the revised EYFS -An overview for Headteachers & Senior Leaders

The revised EYFS framework will become statutory from September 2021. Other, non-statutory documents, such as the revised 'Development Matters', and 'Birth to Three Matters' have also been published. These materials aim to support an effective Early Years pedagogy, well-sequenced curriculum and practitioner knowledge about child development.

This briefing package will give an overview of changes to the EYFS, the new documents that are available and support to use other relevant resources, so that headteachers and senior leaders are confident about the expectations of the revised EYFS.

The training package will consist of:

- A video to watch prior to the online meeting. This will provide an overview of the key principles of the revised Learning and Development requirements, and the reasons for these revisions
- **Survey** giving an opportunity to ask questions that come to mind, that can be answered in the online meeting
- An **online meeting** of organised discussions about leadership of the changes relating to:
 - progression through an effective curriculum
 - data collection and tracking
 - inclusive practice and improved outcomes
- A set of online resources

Outcomes:

- Understand revisions made to the EYFS
- Explore and discuss features of good practice for leadership and monitoring of the EYFS
- Evaluate the continuum of learning from the revised EYFS through the primary phase
- Co-develop a timeline to ensure all staff and children are working confidently within the new framework from September 2021
