

Understanding and Implementing the Engagement Model



The engagement model is an assessment tool that helps schools support pupils who are working below the level of the national curriculum and who are not engaged in subject-specific study (those previously assessed as attaining P1-4). It identifies and celebrates all pupils' progress and can help schools reflect on how well the bespoke curriculum they offer helps all pupils to progress. It adds value to existing in-school assessment processes by helping schools assess pupil progress from a different angle. Each of the 5 areas of engagement will be explored along with pupil progress in development through these. This will differ for each pupil according to their profile of needs as set out in their Education, Health and Care (EHC) plan. The model combines a formative and summative assessment approach which enables the pupils' achievements and progress to be measured over time.

The training will consist of

- **3 online training sessions:**
 - What is engagement and who needs this model?
 - Observations, looking to learn - the templates
 - Planning for engagement, using the EHCP outcomes and making learning meaningful
- **Electronic documents** – to support the use of the model in schools
- **Gap task** – to enable delegates to implement the model in school

Outcomes:

Teachers will be enabled to:

- Understand the 5 areas of engagement
- Develop confidence in accurately assessing these
- Implement the use of the model in their school

Educators of children working below the Pre-Key Stage Standards in mainstream and specialist schools.
