Our service has been designed to support teacher recruitment and retention by giving ECTs high quality support and advice.

Please note this year's provision has been designed to incorporate additional support in light of the early career framework reforms from September 2021.

To meet our statutory obligations

To meet our statutory obligations, we have a rigorous quality assurance programme to ensure compliance against the statutory regulations, which includes:

- Tracking progress to provide the Teaching Regulation Agency (TRA) with all statutory data
- Carrying out routine checks and quality assurance visits
- Making and communicating decisions and recommendations regarding the successful completion, reduction or extension of the induction period
- Completing the 'sign-off' process on behalf of Schools
- Consulting with key stakeholders
- support from a highly experienced and dedicated team for vulnerable ECTs.



To register your ECT

All schools/institutions using Norfolk Local Authority as the Appropriate Body need to register newly appointed ECTs on our electronic online system, ECT Manager. ECT Manager is a paperless system for recording data securely, submitting assessments, accessing resources, raising alerts and managing ECT during induction.

To register, you need to have the following information:

- Teacher Reference Number (to ensure ECT is eligible to start induction)
- The ECTs last name, date of birth
- Details of Early Careers Framework programme of delivery; Full, Core or School Based.

Charges

From September 2021 Schools will be charged £600 for each ECT. This charge covers both years. Where contracts differ Schools will be charged pro rata.

Concessions

Schools with over five ECTs will receive a 10% reduction for each additional ECT registered.



Support package for vulnerable ECTs

For those ECTs who need a higher level of support we can facilitate a personalised programme of support. We can also help mediate difficult situations to promote mutually agreeable resolutions.

- Once an alert is raised an initial meeting will take place to establish areas of challenge and agree the action for additional monitoring and support measures in accordance with the statutory guidance
- Continued monitoring and assessment of progress.
- Mediating difficult situations/conversations
- Representation and support with Appeals
