



Whole-School, Mastery Opportunities for Primary Schools 2021/22

Angles Maths Hub is pleased to offer two starting points of engagement to new schools. Both options focus on developing a whole-school mastery approach to mathematics teaching and learning. These Work Groups allow schools the time and support to create a sustainable and successful model for staff and pupils.

Mastery Readiness

This Work Group focuses on:

- the development of **effective leadership** to support change and teacher professional development in relation to teaching for mastery
- development of **classroom culture and attitudes** to mathematics that will support a teaching for mastery approach, for teachers and pupils

Mastery Readiness is **free of charge** for all primary schools and offers **collaborative Work Group sessions and 1:1 schools visits each half term**.

Participation on the programme leads to a priority place on Mastery Development from September 2022.

Mastery Development

This Work Group supports teachers in developing their own **mathematical and pedagogical knowledge of a mastery approach** within their classroom.

Mastery Development engages teachers in practice-based professional development activity through participation in **teacher research groups (TRGs) each half term**, led by an NCETM accredited Primary Mastery Specialist. Schools also receive a **1:1 visit each term** by their Specialist.

Schools on this programme receive a **£1000 participation grant** to support teacher release costs and a priority place on Embedding Mastery from September 2022.
