We're really excited about the new and reformed suite of National Professional Qualifications this year and we still have some spaces left on for our 2021/2022 NPQs cohort - including the three new specialist NPQs!

The National Professional Qualifications (NPQs) provide training and support for teachers and school leaders at all levels, from those who want to develop expertise in high quality teaching practice, such as behaviour management, to those leading multiple schools across trusts.

From November, we will be offering:

NPQ in Leading Teacher Development is fully funded by the Department for Education (DfE) and enables participants to develop an expertise that is flexible. Those doing this NPQ will be able to diagnose what teachers can do, including professional development, in order to adapt their school's approach based on the teacher's developing knowledge. The NPQLTD is recommended for those who have, or are aspiring to have, responsibilities for leading the development of teachers within their school.

NPQ in Leading Teaching is designed for teachers who have, or are aspiring to have, responsibilities for leading teaching in a subject area, year group, key stage or phase. By undergoing this NPQ, you will learn how to create a culture of high expectations across the school, through articulating, modelling and rehearsing practices that contribute to the intended school culture and the responsibilities every member of the school community has in its creation.

NPQ in Leading Behaviour and Culture demonstrates the essential knowledge, skills and concepts that underpin successful leadership of behaviour and culture. It sets out what those leading behaviour and culture should know and be able to do within the specialist areas related to their role and in relation to how to put new approaches into practice. This NPQ is for those who have, or aspire to have, responsibilities for leading behaviour and/or supporting pupil wellbeing.

Alongside the three specialist NPQs, the existing three leadership NPQs have been reformed for this year, to a new and more flexible format - NPQ in Senior Leadership, NPQ in Headship and NPQ in Executive Leadership. The content has been adapted based on an evidence base approved by the Education Endowment Foundation (EEF). The new frameworks seek to map out what best practice means for school leadership, in a move that takes these NPQs away from a more generic approach to leadership. These courses take 18 months to complete.

The deadline to apply is the 23rd of September.
