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Funding

NPQ in Leading Teacher Development is fully funded for all teachers in statefunded schools in England who have, or are aspiring to have, responsibilities for leading the development of other teachers in their school.

NPQ in Headship is fully funded for all headteachers in their first 24 months in post in state-funded schools in England. This funding is accompanied by an **Additional Support Offer (ASO)** which provides structured, unassessed face-to-face support based on the best available evidence about what makes an effective headteacher.

State-funded schools in England that are within the top 30th percentile in relation to pupils on Pupil Premium receive full funding for **all NPQs**. Contact us to find out if your school qualifies.

How to apply

We are running the following cohorts this autumn (starting in November): NPQH (both providers); NPQSL (both providers); NPQLTD (TDT). Applications close as follows:

- 8 October for Church of England NPQH and NPQSL
- 22 October for Church of England ASO
- 18 October for TDT programmes
- TBC for TDT ASO

We are also running cohorts of all three specialist qualifications in spring (starting in February).

When you have selected your chosen provider, you will need to register on the gov.uk website (search 'DfE register for NPQ'). You will then be able to formally apply via the chosen provider, at which stage more information is required e.g. teaching and leadership experience, name of the sponsor. The final step is for the sponsor (a senior person within your organisation) to endorse the application. Please do get in touch if you have any questions about the application process.



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
