Level 4 Award in Supporting Children & Young People with Speech, Language and Communication Needs

This exciting initiative will enable participants to develop their knowledge and confidence in supporting children and young people with speech, language and communication needs and provide them with the opportunity to develop a range of practical skills to fulfil a school-based support role.

This qualification is suitable for teaching and support staff working in all phases of education; early years, primary, secondary and post-16. On successful completion participants will gain a Level 4 award in supporting children and young people with speech, language and communication and 6 level 4 credits from Gateway Qualifications. Participants will take away an exciting portfolio of work.

The qualification can be accessed online via laptop/tablet/phone. The qualification is being offered in partnership with Norfolk County Council. The qualification is being offered via a blended pathway, with access to the online course materials and 7 short virtual workshop sessions delivered via Teams. Dates for the workshop sessions are outlined below.

Those wishing to participate need to be confident and prepared for study at Level 4 and have the time to complete the qualification (6 credits is equivalent to 60 hours of study over the 9 month duration of the course).

Prior to workshop session 1, participants are asked to familiarise themselves with the learning platform, including the course materials and portfolio.

Prior to subsequent workshop sessions, participants should access the relevant course materials and sections of the portfolio to gain the most from the face-to-face sessions.
