This event aims to give children the chance to witness farming first hand by looking after a ewe and her lamb/s on their school grounds during 21 – 25 March 2022.

The Food and Farming Discovery Trust launched the ‘Learn about Livestock’ project with great success in 2019.

The Food and Farming Discovery Trust will arrange a farmer to deliver everything you need to look after the ewe and lamb/s including food. Schools involved in the scheme will be given full support regarding risk assessments and expert veterinary assistance.

The opportunity is available for up to 14 local schools.

The only requirements are the school needs access to a small grass area which can accommodate a pen and people engaging with the animals.
