

Provision Expected at SEN Support (PEaSS)

The PEaSS (Provision Expected at SEND Support) guidance outlines the provision that the local authority expects to be made available by mainstream schools, academies, free schools, early years and post-16 providers for all children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) in Norfolk.

The session will introduce the PEaSS suite of resources and explore the content so that settings are aware of how to use the materials in their practice, their communications with parent carers, and a settings' roles and responsibilities towards children and young people with SEND.

By the end of the session participants will:

- Be aware of the PEaSS guidance, how to access it via the Local Offer and how to use it in their settings.
