Access Through Technology (ATT) is a small team of specialist teachers and support staff within Norfolk County Council's Children's Services. ATT work with schools across the county, providing assessment, equipment, advice, support and training for children, schools and parents/carers of children who benefit from using technology to communicate and to learn.

They work closely with occupational therapists, speech and language therapists, physiotherapists and sensory support teachers in whatever combination is appropriate for the individual child.
