The competition

Describe in no more than 400 words why you chose those flowers. Maybe they were in the Queen's coronation bouquet, or they are flowers named after the Queen; perhaps you want to design a bouquet of wildflowers or varieties associated with Norfolk.

Who can take part

- The competition is open to every child in your school
- There will be two categories:
 - (1) Reception, year 1 and year 2
 - (2) Years 3 - 6

The prizes

- One winner will be chosen from each of the two categories and these two children will be awarded garden-related prizes.
- From those two winning entries, the judge will decide the overall winner. This child's school will be awarded £500 to spend on garden-related projects and the painting will be displayed at the Royal Norfolk Show.
- There will be a garden-related prize for the winner of the written description
- There will be prizes awarded to highly commended entries.
- Lady Dannatt, her Majesty's Lord-Lieutenant of Norfolk, will judge the competition and present the prizes on 25 May.
