

## Access Through Technology

Access Through Technology (ATT) is a small team of specialist teachers and support staff within Norfolk County Council's Children's Services. We work with schools across the County providing assessment, equipment, training and advice to help schools support identified pupils with significant and complex communication difficulties who may benefit from using technology to communicate and learn.

They work closely with occupational therapists, speech and language therapists, physiotherapists and sensory support teachers in whatever combination is appropriate for the individual child.
