Conditions Of Booking For Norfolk LEA Schools

Please note that for all these courses:

- The LEA is subsidising the full cost of courses to students.
- Use of the Centre minibus for agreed field visits is included.
- Up to four staff places per course are free.

Financial Conditions Of Booking

For your convenience we do not operate a booking deposit system. However the following cancellation penalties will be incurred by schools cancelling booked and confirmed courses. We advise you to take out insurance to cover the costs that might be incurred if you have to cancel a booking.

- 1. If cancellation of a confirmed course is made at any time up to sixteen clear weeks before the beginning of a course then 25% of the total course fees shall be payable.
- 2. If cancellation is made between the period of sixteen and eight clear weeks before the course begins, then a cancellation fee of 50% of the total course fees due shall be payable. If the booking can be allocated to another school then only 25% of the total course fees shall be payable.
- 3. If cancellation is made less than eight clear weeks before the course begins, then a cancellation fee comprising the total course fees due shall be payable. If the week can be allocated to another school then only 25% of the total course fees shall be payable.
- 4. Total course fees due will be based on whichever amount is the higher between the number of places booked and the minimum fee.
- 5. If for any unforeseen reason the Centre has to cancel your course, every effort will be made to re-book you.
