





Arranging and Chairing Effective Annual Reviews

Outline

All children and young people with an EHCP must have an annual review at least yearly. To help inform the annual review decision, setting SENDCOs gather evidence via an annual review meeting and complete an annual review report. This training is designed to provide an overview of the annual review process for SENDCOs new to the role and for more experienced SENDCOs who would like to know about the latest guidance and paperwork available to support them.

- Understanding the annual review timeframes
- How to ensure the child or young person's voice is meaningfully included
- Working effectively with families
- The latest NCC paperwork and guidance
