This fully funded twilight and accompanying resources will provide settings and practitioners with the tools to plan and support effective transitions for children and young people, including those with SEND.

Description

Effective planning for transition is essential to secure good outcomes, particularly at phase transfer, when children and young people move from one stage of education to another.

The twilight session will cover:

- The importance of effective transition, particularly for children and young people with SEN, additional needs or disabilities
- Best practice principles and the graduated approach to transition
- The importance of person-centred planning
- Key tools and resources to support settings, families and children and young people
- Case study examples of good practice
- An opportunity to reflect on barriers and share examples of good practice

Outcomes

Delegates will:

- Understand the importance of leading and planning for transition and the need for a graduated approach
- Be able to access a range of resources and tools to support settings, families and children and young people with transition
- Consider potential barriers to effective transition and identify potential solutions, sharing examples of best practice
