





SEND Data and Census twilight 2022-23

Outline

The session will enable delegates to understand the Norfolk and national context around SEND data. It will provide tools to support settings to compare this to their own data.

Reference will be made to the SEND Review and Schools white paper and to Norfolk SEND tools for whole setting and pupil identification of needs and evaluation of provision.

Description

The session will review the national and Norfolk data context for mainstream primary and secondary settings, including:

- % SEN Support and % EHCP
- % CYP in each of the four broad categories of need
- % CYP in the wider (January) census categories
- Attendance and exclusions data
- Progress and attainment data
- Data Dashboard
- INDES, IPSEF

The session will consider SEND coding for the census and provide guidance around the completion of the 'Inclusion in a nutshell' tool.

Outcomes

Delegates will:

- Be aware of the context of Norfolk and national SEND data
- Be supported to compare data for their own setting to these data sets and identify key lines of enquiry arising from this
- Understand SEND coding for the census
- Understand how to use the 'Inclusion in a nutshell' tool
