Help us create a new library and learning centre for the borough



Great Yarmouth Borough Council bought the former Palmers building in Great Yarmouth last year and is now working with partners to transform it into a £15.4m library and learning centre, offering courses up to university level and beyond.

The hub will be a new home for Norfolk County Council's Great Yarmouth Library, along with adult learning, registry office and other community services such as Citizens Advice.

Alongside Norfolk County Council's new programme of adult learning, East Coast College is working with the University of Suffolk to offer university level courses, access to higher education, and adult learning. The University of East Anglia will also offer courses.

The project partners want to hear from the public on the detail of what should feature inside the building, with an online survey giving the chance to give your views on what library services and what courses should be offered.
