

KS1: Achieving Accuracy in Statutory Assessment

Outline

This is a series of 3 training events that together will support those who are experienced in Year 2 and those new to Year 2, in planning for achievement of the criteria in the assessment frameworks for all, by the end of KS1.

The training events will take place face to face to allow discussion and collaboration with colleagues from across the county and beyond.

At each of the dates, we will unpick criteria, qualifiers and inclusive access arrangements, to enable teachers to plan effective, individualised curricula across English and maths. Delegates will be enabled to use the frameworks to make accurate assessment judgements using common evidence bases, to feel confident about assessing the attainment of those working below the standard (PKS), working towards the standard (WTS), working at the expected standard (EXS), and working at a greater depth within the standard (GDS).

Description:

The training will consist of three face-to face training events that will allow discussion and collaboration with colleagues from across the county and beyond.

Session 1 will focus on writing, session 2 on mathematics, and session 3 on reading. Delegates will reflect on the curriculum on offer for their children for each of these subject areas, the suitability of this for each child, the sequential nature of each subject and how it fits within the planned wider curriculum. There will be a focus on how formative assessment enables accurate evaluation and redesigning of the curriculum to ensure success for all children at the end of the key stage. We will unpick each standard of each subject area for the end of key stage assessment frameworks.

- **Electronic documents** – an assessment handbook will be shared containing all you need to know as a Y2 teacher, along with supporting resources, research and further online support.

Location:

Sessions will take place face to face at 2 venues across the county. Please see below for more information.

Audience:

Year 2 class teachers (established and new), colleagues from Y1 or Y3, teaching assistants, English and maths leads.

Booking information:

This training is fully funded for all maintained Norfolk schools and for academies who subscribe to Norfolk statutory assessment monitoring services. Places will be limited to 3 delegates per setting, initially. Academies who do not subscribe to Norfolk monitoring services are welcome to book places and will be charged £60 per delegate.

Delegates must ensure they attend all 3 sessions over the course of the year.
