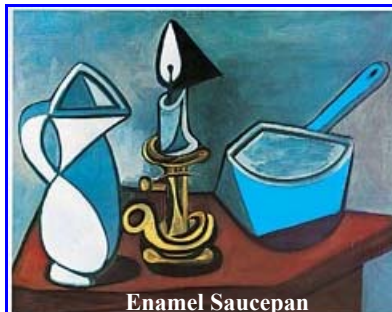

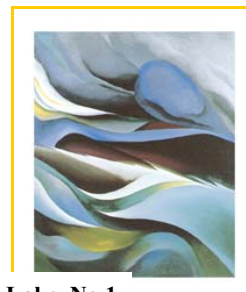

Many schools find it difficult to provide resources to cover the requirements of the QCA Schemes of Work for Art.

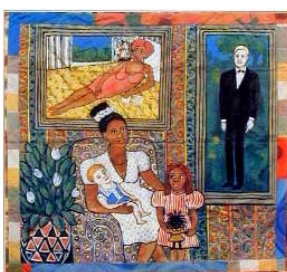
We have combined with Shorewood Educational Trust to make available for loan to schools packs of prints to support each of the QCA Art Units from Years 1 to 6.

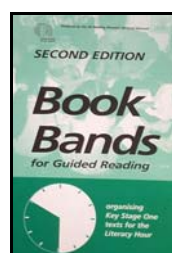
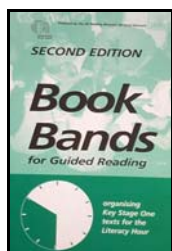
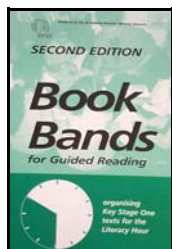

GUIDED READING FOR KS1 **NOW AVAILABLE TO MATCH THE** **BOOK BANDS FOR GUIDED READING** **CATCH-UP BOOK BOXES**

Our guided reading loan service – six copies of five different titles as a loan box – can now be matched even more closely to the reading needs of your children. We have a range of titles available in all Bands from band 2 to Band 10. We can supply boxes for any individual band, and we are always happy to mix up a range of bands in a single box.

Don't forget that Guided Readers are loaned for a term, but are exchangeable *free of charge* at half term.

We have been working closely with Julie Lawes, the Catch-Up Director, to develop and refine our support for Catch-Up work at Years 2,3 and 4.
