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## TIMELINE

**2022/2023 – project development**  
participating schools & providers engaged, platform designed

**September 2022 – project goes live**

**Destinations stage**  
**Sept – Dec:** Schools upload applications and INDES to Help You Choose

**Transitions stage**  
**Jan – March:** Post 16 Providers download 1<sup>st</sup> choice applications and INDES to start transitions with Young People, their Families

**Learner Journey stage**  
**April - June:** Publish case studies about the pilot and next steps

**24 members access a Sharepoint for communications and resources, Surgeries**  
**November – April,** Communications Pack, Functional

NCC has started a 12-month pilot establishing an effective transfer of SEND information, using the INDES profiler, between School and Post 16 providers using 'Help You Choose' for Y12 study options.

Seamlessly transferring INDES data from Y11, the pilot enables Post 16 providers to better prepare and support young people with SEND joining them each September.

The pilot is already developing online platforms for easy communication and transfers safely with consent and GDPR data protection.

## Benefits of the trial

- Clear profile of young people's needs for access and inclusion in Y12
- Early identification helps Post 16 providers for successful transition to Y12
- Supports referrals across different services including Social Care & Health
- Supports EHC needs assessment requests and annual EHCP review
- Co-production with Young People and their Families
- Post 16 Providers prepared for INDES role in new Element 3 funding after 2024 TBC
