Description

The course will provide an overview of the different types of SRBs which are available to schools within Norfolk: Autism bases, Learning and Cognition (LCN) bases, Speech, Language and Communication (SLCN) bases and Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) bases, alongside a small number of bases which provide for more specialist needs.

This session will include a description of the provision at each type of SRB, their locations and the broad criteria that pupils are expected to meet to access the bases.

This will be followed by a step-by-step guide to the referral process, including timescales and the dates for the various placement panel meetings. There will also be details of how schools will be expected to engage with an SRB placement, alongside outreach that can be offered by SRBs.

Outcomes

School leaders and SENDCos will be confident in when and how to refer a pupil to an SRB.
