YCS Outdoor Education Programme Youth Club

The youth club is based at Filby Broad and is available to young people aged 13-19 yrs. We run sessions Feb-Apr on Saturday mornings, May-Sept Tuesday evenings and revert back to Saturdays Mid Sept-Dec (as we run out of daylight). Each session costs £2 collected when you arrive. The club provides the opportunity for participation and development in a range of watersports (whatever your ability) in a safe environment with qualified instructors. All our staff are locally or nationally qualified instructors and coaches under the relevant Local/National Governing Body in addition to holding a current first aid qualification.

All our centres are AALA licensed and hold relevant centre recognition and approved teaching establishment status. These include sailing and powerboating (Royal Yachting Association), canoeing and kayaking (British Canoe Union).







Charges for use of YCS Outdoor Education Centres

Group bookings using any YCS Outdoor Education Centre, are charged per instructor per hour based on a group ratio of 1:6.

Each centre operates with a YCS Outdoor Education Programme Senior Instructor in charge.

Our charges include insurance, relevant equipment/ clothing (where appropriate), venue and delivery of the session(s).
