# Developing Drama Within Circle Time

The structure and philosophy of circle time shares much with drama practice. Both supportively build a sense of class community and are based on agreed contracts of personal and class behaviour. Both share some similar strategies and conventions which offer active participation to all pupils and encourage co-operation, the development of self awareness and confidence, as well as a range of social skills.

This course will:

- define similarities practically between circle time and drama
- offer strategies for developing fictions collectively within circles
- consider the ways in which established circle time activities can be developed through working in role.

This course supports the Healthy Schools, PSHE and Citizenship agendas, as well as promoting the Arts across the curriculum.
