Behaviour Management Workshop for Secondary Teaching Assistants

These one day practical workshops are intended to give teaching assistants an intensive opportunity to examine and try out classroom behaviour management techniques. The day will involve participants in discussion of low level non-verbal and verbal de-escalation and intervention strategies as well as some analysis of dealing with more challenging conflict situations. Participants will need to be prepared to take part in role-plays, simulations and video recording of parts of the day's work in order to demonstrate techniques and practice interventions.

Course Objectives:

- to identify and share current behaviour management skills;
- to identify additional behaviour management skills;
- to better understand the use of low key intervention and de-escalation strategies;
- to be better equipped to deal with more challenging conflict situations.
