





Supporting transition to secondary settings

Outline

This fully funded twilight will provide primary and secondary settings with an opportunity to share different approaches and identify best practice in supporting effective transitions for children and young people from Y6-Y7, with a focus on those with additional needs/ SEND. The session builds on the general good practice principles covered in a previous transition twilight.

Description

Early, effective planning for transition is essential to secure positive outcomes for CYP, particularly those with high level needs at phase transfer to secondary settings. The twilight session will include:

- Current context and key themes arising
- Four 'spotlight' sessions where settings present an overview of their approaches to supporting transition to high school (one primary and three secondary settings)
- An opportunity to reflect and discuss what works well and what could be developed further to support effective transitions, particularly for CYP with complex needs

Outcomes

Delegates will:

- Understand the value and impact of early strategic transition planning
- Understand approaches secondary settings are developing and using to meet the needs of CYP, particularly those with complex needs
- Understand the value and impact of partnership working between primary and secondary settings on the outcomes for children and young people and their families
- Peer review and connect professionally with other settings
