Progressing from Dramatic Play to Drama in the Foundation Stage

Dramatic role play is an important and compelling, natural learning medium for young children. Drama can support and integrate all areas of learning in the Foundation Stage. This course will support teachers in recognising and developing relevant play based drama skills. It will offer advice on the gradual introduction of drama strategies to young children and on effective teacher intervention and support in class role play and drama lessons. The effectiveness of working in role to support learning will be a key area of focus.
