Sarah is a former Norfolk Headteacher and Developing experts is a very easily accessible platform which has 700 science lesson plans and experiments for children between the ages of four and fourteen, which help schools teach science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) and inspire pupils into future careers in the field.
