Supporting Dramatic Play and Active Storydrama in Foundation and Key Stage 1

Make believe role play and playacting stories are important ways for young children to make sense of their world. The sensitive and informed intervention and support of an adult (sometimes in role) can move the playacting into focussed learning.

This course for teaching assistants will consider practice in role play areas. The skills involved in dramatic play will be reviewed and simple activities that practice drama skills will be offered. Participants will be introduced to basic drama strategies and techniques which can be applied to storytelling and storymaking in and out of role play areas.
