Day 3: Thursday 15th June - Lesson Study of mastery teaching and learning (EY), giving feedback and evidencing learning in EY

Each Work Group session will be hosted by **Lavenham Primary School** and will run from **9.30am - 3pm**. Refreshments will be available but participants are asked to **bring their own lunch**.

Between sessions, participants will be asked to carry out short learning activities back in their own setting to practise and consolidate learning from the Work Group sessions.
