- Understand the roles and responsibility of schools and the Local Authority in relation to enabling trips.
- Understand the role of the EVC within the school environment
- Know how to access support, having received practical advice and high quality training
- Be able to follow the Local Authority's approval process
- Have an increased awareness of planning and risk management
- Have an introduction to EVOLVE, the internet based notification/approval system.
