Cross-Curricular ICT at Key Stages 1 and 2

During the day we will explore a model for development which is based on a strategic view of the issue. Delegates will develop a clear view of the options and development routes. They will be able to make a systematic appraisal of the strength of ICT to support learning in their school, make informed decisions and engage in discussions with colleagues. The day will inform Development Planning and Action Planning.

Developing the use of ICT to support learning across the curriculum is a LEA priority; it is featured in the Education Development plan. The government plans to release a further £100 million e-learning credits in the spring of 2004.
