A Look at School Designed Units for Key Stage 2 RE

The QCA scheme of work requires schools to develop additional units to match their local syllabus. This course will make practical suggestions for School Designed units to supplement the QCA scheme of work and thus enable a school to fulfil its legal requirements to teach the Norfolk Agreed Syllabus.

The day will be spent looking at four units designed to do this for Norfolk; these will be written in the QCA format and include many useful ideas for teaching activities and assessment. They will also include resource details.

We will look at a unit on Christian beliefs (Why is Jesus so important to Christians?) and three units to match the 'Questions of Meaning' section of the Norfolk Syllabus. (Who is in charge of our world? What is life for? What ideas do people have about God?).

Resources (books, videos and artefacts) suitable for teaching these KS 2 units will be on display throughout the day.
