What Issues do Muslims in Britain Face Today?

This course is for Y7 teachers or RE Subject Leaders who want to explore ideas for School Designed Units to supplement the QCA units for KS 3. The unit 'What Issues do Muslims Face in Britain Today?' follows the QCA model and offers practical support for both specialist and non-specialist RE teachers.

This course will enable course participants to:-

- move pupils on from work on Islam in KS 2
- consider some interesting and challenging classroom activities
- evaluate resources for teaching the unit, eg. books, videos and web-sites
- interview some local Muslims, where possible.

Resources (books, videos and artefacts) suitable for teaching about different religions at KS3 will be on display throughout the session.

This half-day course can be taken as a supplement to the course 'Teaching RE at KS3' or on its own.
