Key Stage 3 - Learning Styles and Writing in Mathematics

Understanding the brain and how people learn has been growing over the last twenty years. The roles of the senses in learning, long appreciated as 'See it - Hear it - Do it' are now more formalised as visual, auditory and kinaesthetic learning styles.

During this course, we will:

- consider the implications for teachers of Mathematics,
- review current practice in teaching writing in the light of what we know about learning,
- identify a range of techniques in use that draw upon different learning styles,
- identify how all pupils might best access the writing curriculum, and
- develop a rationale for innovative approaches to enabling effective writing.
