QCA has developed software to support the analysis of end of Key Stage and optional tests in all subjects. This software is being sent to all schools, free of charge, for use with the 2003 national curriculum and new optional tests.

The software is easy to use and consists of spreadsheets which require the input of data. It has been designed to support teachers in using national curriculum test data to analyse pupil performance.

Analysis may be done by:

- assessment focus (English)
- attainment target (Maths and Science)

- level

N.B. This software has been developed to be compatible with Windows 2000 and XP running Office 2000, XP only.

Individual/group strengths, areas for improvement and useful information at a particular level may be identified. Analyses from the software will help to inform future teaching and learning strategies, planning and review strategies.
