This practical course will deal largely with the Early Learning Goal for cultures and beliefs, which forms part of the Foundation area: Knowledge and Understanding of the World. Through a focus on the handling and use of religious artefacts, it will also:

- look at a variety of ways of deepening children's knowledge of cultures and beliefs, including stories, music, badges, symbols, candles, toys
- consider the use of visitors to the setting from a range of religious and ethnic groups and the possibilities of visiting local places of worship
- offer practical information on principal religions in Britain to help practitioners take account of issues to do with festivals, diet, dress, attitudes to music and art
- explore briefly the requirement for Religious Education in the Reception year.
