## Essential Skills for Undertaking Classroom Observation

Several schools have requested a course on developing classroom observation skills. It is designed for senior managers and subject leaders with no or limited experience in this area as well as those who would like to refine their practice. Simulation exercises using video tapes or lessons will be used during the session.

By the end of the course, participants will be:

- aware of the value of lesson observations as evidence of effective teaching and learning
- aware of the protocols to follow to ensure that the observation is a constructive experience for all concerned
- able to use evidence gathered from lesson observations to make judgements about pupils' experiences in lessons
- aware of how to give constructive feedback to teachers.
