Outline

This twilight session will cover the approach to supporting participation for children and young people (CYP) in Norfolk, with a particular focus on supporting the participation of CYP with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND).

Description

The session will provide an opportunity for delegates to:

- Find out about Norfolk's approach to hearing the voice of CYP and families
- Learn how CYP can get involved and the benefits for them
- Explore why hearing young people's voices is important
- Identify opportunities in Norfolk for CYP with SEND to get involved and have their voices heard
- Reflect on their settings' approach to engaging CYP with SEND and consider how this could be enhanced

Delegates will:

- Find out about the approach to participation for CYP in Norfolk, with a focus on SEND
- Be aware of opportunities for CYP with SEND to participate, including through groups such as the [DRAGONS](#) (Disability Real Action Group of Norfolk) and [Norfolk SEND Youth Forum](#)
- Know how to find resources and further information to support participation of CYP with SEND in their settings
- Share ideas and best practice with colleagues
