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# The Environment as a Stimulus for Asking Questions and Investigating Answers

Many teachers find undertaking investigations in the environment difficult to identify and manage. A short walk through part of Wells Pinewoods will provide us with opportunities to observe, ask, predict, investigate and record real scientific questions.

Participants will:

- gain confidence to enable them to help children tackle science investigations at KS2, using only simple equipment
- develop strategies to encourage children to ask questions in a form that can be investigated and recorded
- look at areas of the science curriculum where investigations could take place and identify a range of possible investigations for their locality
- consider the management issues of investigations in the environment.
