Behaviour Management Workshop for Primary Teaching Assistants

These one day practical workshops are intended to give teaching assistants an intensive opportunity to examine and try out classroom behaviour management techniques. The day will involve participants in discussion of low level non-verbal and verbal de-escalation and intervention strategies as well as some analysis of dealing with more challenging conflict situations.
