

Behaviour and Attendance pilot - Spring 2005 training modules

To introduce and explore the following 4 training modules:

The importance of emotions in the classroom:

- to reflect on and deepen their understanding about emotions;
- to explore how the emotions of adults in the classroom impact upon children's emotions, behaviour, attendance and learning;
- to develop strategies for managing emotions (both our own and those of children) within the learning environment.

Understanding behaviour:

- to develop an understanding of what may lie behind certain behaviours;
- to explore how behaviour can change;
- to explore a model of classroom dynamics.

Relationships in the classroom:

- how relationships are developed and maintained;
- the importance of establishing positive relationships with all children;
- how to promote positive relationships with children.

Setting expectations and teaching positive behaviour:

- to introduce the concept of classroom rights and responsibilities;
- to develop practical strategies for promoting clear classroom expectations;
- to develop or review a classroom behaviour plan.
