AN EXCITING, INNOVATIVE INSET OPPORTUNITY FOR THE SUMMER TERM

A practical full day course to assist senior managers in their role of supporting and leading school self-review.

The course aims to develop analytical skills by raising awareness of the processes and techniques involved in school self-review. It will enable participants to gain a greater understanding of the quality of education provided in their own school.
