TEACCH: Introductory Workshop by Asperger Norfolk

An introduction to the "TEACCH" approach for people with limited knowledge of Autistic Spectrum Disorders (ASD). This course suitable for teachers and teaching assistants from primary and secondary schools.

TEACCH is a structured teaching approach which maximises the visual presentation and minimises verbal instruction. The structure is aimed at making the best use of the strengths of children with ASD, their visual skills and adherence to routine, therefore using these strengths to help minimise their difficulties.
