Description

This twilight session focusses on high quality teaching and looks in detail at Teachers' Standard 5 which specifies that teachers must 'Adapt teaching to respond to the strengths and needs of all pupils.'

The session will

- review responsibilities and the legislative framework
- focus on how to identify and meet need in the classroom using a range of strategies and approaches
- signpost to resources and key sources of guidance to achieve this goal

- be aware of strategies and approaches to identify and meet a range of needs
- know where to access further guidance and resources
- share good practice with colleagues from other Norfolk settings
