

INDES Moderation Panel (IMP) Process twilight

Outline

The session will enable delegates to understand what INDES Moderation is and how it informs a setting on quality SEND identification and provision at an individual and whole setting level.

Description

The session will explain the process of INDES Moderation Panel for primary and secondary settings, including:

- The role of the moderators, independent observers, and facilitators
- A 'walk through' of the moderator's role. For example, how a setting's INDES Levels (iLevels) for an individual align or map to information submitted
- Consideration of a setting's capacity to meet SEND across the school
- How outcomes from the process can inform the Support for SEND Triage (SST) process, to assist the setting's Quality Assurance process for SEND provision

Outcomes

Delegates will:

- Understand the process of INDES moderation as Quality Assurance for their SEND offer
- Understand the role of the moderator by school SEND professionals involved in the process
- Understand how a setting's INDES and IPSEF reports with submitted information, inform support offered at individual and whole school levels
