Behaviour and Attendance pilot - Summer 2005 training modules

To introduce and explore the following 4 training modules:

Effective lessons and behaviour for learning:

- to explore how lesson structures can promote behaviour for learning:
- to consider the importance of classroom routines;
- to develop strategies and techniques for explicitly teaching specific behaviours needed for learning.

Working with colleagues on behaviour issues:

- to explore issues relating to working with colleagues to promote positive behaviour;
- to increase the confidence of participants in supporting professional development within their own establishment;
- to consider the adaptation and using of training materials to meet the needs of a specific audience or context.

Responding to inappropriate behaviour:

- effective consequences for children who behave inappropriately;
- a framework for using those consequences;
- a range of classroom intervention strategies and when each strategy is best used;
- ways of maintaining adult and child self-esteem through win-win scenarios;
- ways of involving school-based support in using consequences.

Consequences:

- to consider how the consequences that follow behaviour can influence and promote positive behaviour and regular attendance;
- to explore ways of helping children take responsibility for their behaviour and attendance;
- to explore how systems of positive consequences, used with individuals and whole classes, promote positive behaviour and attendance;
- to develop some principles and practice relating to consequences used in response to inappropriate behaviour.
