This is the second Gifted and Talented Conference for the County. The theme is creativity and the able child. The main objective of this conference is to give teachers new and fresh ideas about working creatively with our most able pupils.

Guest speakers include:

Belle Wallace, President of the National Association for Able Children in Education

Belle has worked in an advisory capacity for Essex LEA, was Co-Director of the Curriculum Development Unit and has designed and was senior author of a series of language and thinking skills texts to redress cognitive underdevelopment in pupils 6-17 years. She now works as a consultant on the Education of Gifted and Talented Pupils, both nationally and internationally. Belle is the author of 10 books including the NACE-Fulton Publishers Thinking Skills series.

Sophie Weeks, Learning Strategy and Programmes Manager, British Library

Sophie's role is to embed the learning methodology across their programme, including projects, real and virtual workshops and resources. Sophie also devises and manages the onsite programme at the Library.

Philip Davis, Senior Manager, Accelerated Learning in Training and Education

Professional songwriter, Philip Davis is part of the senior management team at Bannockburn Primary in south east London. There, he puts into practice his belief that music should permeate all areas of the curriculum, helping to motivate and inspire children. Philip has taught in London since 1991, mainly in challenging circumstances. As a highly creative teacher he uses music to enhance literacy, numeracy and brain break activities as well as to cultivate the children's own imagination. He believes that at the heart of learning is fun, and music can be used to enable this and motivate all learners.


