Sexuality is one of the most important influences on the development of children and young people - and that means ALL children and young people. Whatever our abilities and disabilities, we are all sexual beings and have similar rights and needs.

A growing number of children and young people, especially those with physical or moderate learning disabilities, are being integrated into mainstream schools. Whatever their disabilities, the sexual development of these children and young people generally takes place within the normal age range. It is the combination of slower cognitive development with the physical and emotional development of puberty and adolescence, and the increased susceptibility to abuse that makes SRE particularly important for these children and young people. This makes it imperative that appropriate and effective methods are used to help them develop the range of personal and social skills to form effective relationships.

Two twilight sessions are being held which will explore methods to enable teaching assistants to support pupils during their sexual development.
